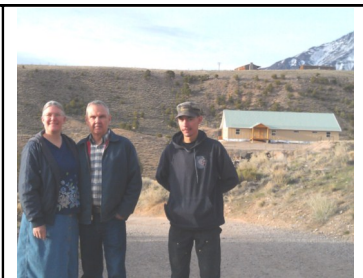

Deuteronomy 32 speaks of God's care of Israel, his chosen people. This passage tells how God found them in the wilderness, instructed them, and nurtured them so that they had an abundant and victorious life. That is our vision and our prayer for the young men God would send us—to see them leave the wilderness behind and learn from God how to live the victory life!

Helpers we need now:

Welding—vent tube for kitchen vent hood and escape ladders in window wells

Plumbing—sprinklers in dorm rooms and fire suppression system in kitchen, plus setting the rest of the toilets and sinks

Carpentry—doors and trim, drop ceilings in six rooms and the hall

Metal siding, soffit, and fascia on the deck area

Stone work—below metal siding and on exterior of entrance

Praise the Lord! We have obtained a temporary use permit and will be using the multi-purpose room in the building for our first Biblical Counseling Seminar May 30—June 1. Pastor Todd Tjepkema from Tri-City Ministries in Chandler, AZ, will be our speaker. The Seminar will consist of ten messages and will run from dinner at 5:00 p.m. Thursday until the noon meal on Saturday. Several have already signed up. We have been scrambling to get some bathroom facilities functional for the Seminar. We now have two functioning toilets and need three more downstairs as well as seven sinks. It is a huge milestone for us to be able to use the building. Please pray that we will have it finished in time for school. The families of five young men are hoping to enroll them in the school this fall.

Where do we stand?

Since the beginning of the year, the Lord has enabled us to check off quite a bit!

STAGE 1

- Septic System
- Sheetrock
- Texture and paint
- Functional bathroom
- Sprinkler/alarm system
- Finish siding, soffit, and fascia

STAGE 2

- Floor grinding
- Tile is going down!
- Carpet and kitchen floor

STAGE 3

- Drop ceiling
- Doors, trim, cabinetry, shelving

STAGE 4

- 1/2 Finish electrical (except fixtures)
- Three more toilets, seven sinks

STAGE 5

- Furnishings, equipment, décor
- 1/2 Kitchen appliances

STAGE 6

- Landscaping, walkways, parking

The materials for the remainder of these projects will cost around \$48,000. (Not too much after all the Lord has done!) We are prayerfully planning to open our doors in the fall for the school year.
