What a blessing it has been to see God provide for this project over the past year with funds and skilled volunteer laborers! Nine teams have traveled to Marysvale giving their time and talents to help see Phase One

on to completion.



Over \$40,000 was given by 80 of God's people in 2013 for a total of \$212,000 since January 1, 2005. Praise the Lord, the entire project is debt-free!

In order to complete the downstairs — Phase One — and begin ministering to at-risk teen boys, we need \$38,000 more. This will allow us to finish the exterior and drop ceiling, and purchase carpet, lighting, and the rest of the plumbing fixtures. It will also enable us to finish furnishing the kitchen and laundry room and build bunk beds in the dorm rooms, storage shelves, and other built-ins.


