Housed within its facility will be a boarding school for at-risk teenage boys, a counseling center for burned-out Christian workers, and a retreat and conference center. Also under the umbrella of Eagle's Nest will be a resource center for women in crisis, as well as industrial arts and construction training for missionaries.

EAGLE'S NEST ACADEMY: Raising children in today's world is difficult, and many situations arise that cause parents to seek help for struggling teens. Eagle's Nest will provide a basic traditional Christian education, plus an emphasis on industrial arts training and other hands-on instruction designed to teach character, responsibility, and resourcefulness. Teenage quiet, comfortable place to rest, renew spiritual and physical strength, and strengthen family bonds. Godly counsel will be available from a strictly biblical perspective to help resolve conflict and determine the will of God for the future. We would like to reward faithful servants of God by not charging for their stay at Eagle's Nest and will be relying on the generosity of God's people to make this aspect of the ministry possible.

TRAINING FOR MISSIONARIES: The most important work of missions is evangelizing and establishing local churches, but a big part of this work is in the realm of the practical. Eagle's Nest, therefore, will provide training in certain areas of practicality: building construction; basic plumbing; automobile maintenance and repair; basic electrical wiring; and resource-

WHAT GOD HAS DONE!

This ministry has come about as a result of a longstand-

ing burden in the hearts of Jonathan and Chrissa Edwards. Because they have seen the need to provide a training ground for future leaders in churches and Christian homes, and because they have seen a high burnout rate among Christian workers, the Edwards' have had a desire to make a place where these needs can be



addressed. The Lord is raising up others who also share the burden and plan to help in the ministry once it is up and running.

The Edwardses are both graduates of Bob Jones University and are 38-year veteran missionaries under Northwest Baptist Missions, Inc. They have been used to plant three Independent Baptist churches in the state of Utah. In 1995, they moved to Marysvale, Utah, and founded Marysvale Baptist Church, converting the only bar in town into a nice church facility. Chrissa has been teaching Special Education for the local elementary schools for the past several years. They have also been active in providing horses for Camp Utibaca (Utah Independent Baptist Camp). God has richly blessed them with a lovely 200-acre ranch nestled in the shadow of the majestic Tushar Mountains.

Eagle's Nest has been the recipient of about twenty-nine acres donated from the ranch and is situated in a beautiful little valley. In the past six years, **100 donors** have contributed about **\$180,000**. This has enabled us to build debt-free. During that same time, **more than 160 volunteers** have **worked well over 8,000 hours**. God has sent just the right people with the expertise needed for the part of the building that was under construction at the time. Dozens of women and men, too, have cooked for all the teams.

- drop ceiling


- stonework, siding
